For Your Information - Today, I received a letter from Michael Hartford, NVD Community Planning Department, which had attached a letter dated 27 September 2001 making application to renovate a total of 50,420 square feet of the existing 53,575 square feet of the Save-On-Food store in Pemberton Plaza and add an additional 4,870 to the existing supermarket. On top of this, they are requesting that a total deficiency of 29 parking spaces.

The first sentence in the final paragraph states "Due to the nature of the application, it is not expected that there will be a public information meeting held."

This item has not been referred to the Marine Drive Corridor Committee and appears to be in conflict with the proposed 40,000 square foot maximum big box store bylaw that Council is considering.
