Our research indicates the following:

Your letter dated December 31 entitled "Construction Noise Bylaw" was received in the Clerk's Office on January 2. An acknowledgement card was sent from the Clerk's Office indicating that the letter had been circulated to the members of Council on January 7 via their Information Package. The card also indicated that the letter had been referred to Mr. Zerr to handle and advise since the Noise Bylaw is within his area of expertise.

I understand that staff are reviewing FONVCA's request for changes to the Bylaw in order that they may provide Council with relevant information before further action is considered. Mr. Sigston has advised me that he has discussed this matter with you and will be responding further shortly. Individual Council members may, of course, also choose to respond to your letter. This is in keeping with Council's policy for handling of correspondence addressed to Mayor and Council.

Unfortunately, your letter dated January 14 entitled "Anti-SLAPP Legislation" does not appear to have been received in our office. Our Administrative Coordinator, Mr. Fleming, conducted a search and there is no record of our receipt of this letter. We will ensure that a copy of that letter is provided to the members of Council in today's Information Package.
