> A MESSAGE FROM ERNIE CRIST:

> North Vancouver District Councillor, Ernie Crist has sent a letter to Mr. Jeremy Dalton expressing his gratitude for Mr Dalton's efforts to lift the sanctions imposed on him in February 2003. Mr. Dalton appeared as a delegation before Council on Sept 8, 2003.


> The sanctions imposed on Councillor Crist were the direct result of the Councillor's divulging information to the press regarding the alleged Northlands Fraud case. Crist claimed that Mayor Bell attempted to sweep the alleged scandal under the rug. He also claimed that Council was misled. He told the press that District Staff knew but failed to inform Council about the alleged fraud when they urged Council to renew an existing contract with Don Mac Holdings for another five years. Don Mac was the company under contract to maintain the Northlands Golf Course.

> Mr. Dalton addressed Council stating that the reasons for the sanctions against the Councillor could be none other than his efforts to bring the Northlands scandal to the public's attention. Mr Dalton cited several examples of his own difficulties to obtain information pertaining to the alleged fraud.

> At a previous regular Council meeting, District Mayor Bell had stated that the reason for the sanctions imposed on Councillor Crist, including depriving him of being Acting Mayor in February 2003, was the result of an alleged incident in 2001. This could not be, however, since Councillor Crist, upon the election of a new Council in November 2002, had been appointed Acting Mayor by Council for the months of January and February 2003.

> Councillor Crist also extended his sincere thanks to Mr. Pat Higgs, a District resident and community activist, for his verbal support on the same issue.
