Hello,


The number 44 UBC, the only reliable transit from the seabus terminal to UBC has a terrible schedule! Taking a 7:45am 236 bus from Pemberton and 22nd in the district, I arrive at waterfront at 8:15 - just in time to miss a 44 UBC! If I take an 8:15 am 236 from pemberton and 22nd in the district, I arrive at waterfront at 8:45am - just in time, yet again, to miss the 44 UBC! The 44 UBC has not been scheduled this year to coincide with seabus arrivals at waterfront. Myself and many other north van city and district residents were left stranded after getting off the seabus at 8:45am. We had to wait until a 44 UBC arrived at 9:07am, making me personally late for class at UBC by 20 minutes. In past years the 44 UBC has arrived at times more convenient for seabus passengers so that the long commute from the district has been less painful. So far this is not the case this school year! Please do what you can to adjust the 44 UBC departure from Seymour and Cordova, for example having the 44 UBC depart at this point at 8:50 instead of 8:45am - so that district and city residents have efficient transit to UBC.
