Dear Mr. Keays:

I have read you letter on the re numbering of homes in the Sunshine and Woodlands Communities. I concur with your comments.

It makes sense to me that simply renumbering the houses in the area will not make it easier to find the addresses and we all know the debacle of a few months ago when neither the RCMP nor the Ambulance could find a house located at end of the Main Road which should have been easy to find and would have been easy to find if the area had been mapped on the principle of street naming as is the case in the rest of the District.

I also agree with your point that each separate lane should have it's own name and residents should discontinue using "Indian River Drive" or "Fire lane" in reference to their address. I also concur with your suggestion that the use of numbers in the 5000 range does not make sense.

As I see it this is an opportunity for the District to do things right and follow the advise of the residents who are familiar with the area. I hope that our staff will listen and act accordingly. I will send a copy of this letter to the Mayor and Council as well as to staff including Mr. Bydwell. I will also send copy to the Federation of North Vancouver Community Associations (FONVCA)
