> A quick update on snow removal.

> Streets staff pre-treated key roads and hills yesterday afternoon in  
> anticipation of the snow. Although the snow only began in earnest  
> about 5:30 AM this morning a crew was working the main roads as of  
> 4AM. Most crews were out before 6AM and all are now working. We will  
> be moving immediately to 24 hour shifts until the snow abates. As you  
> know the snow response policy calls for major arterials to be the  
> focus of attention until the snow stops, at which point we deal with  
> secondary residential streets.

> Notwithstanding our response, the Upper Level and key hills in the  
> District are pretty treacherous.
