> NOTICE OF MOTION - CLARIFICATION ON THE USE OF MOUNTAIN VIEW PARK FOR MOUNTAIN BIKING AND THE RESULTING IMPACT ON THE ENVIRONMENTAL INTEGRITY OF THIS PARK - Councillor Crist

> Whereas Council, in its decision in the Summer and Fall of 2003 and based on a staff report dated Nov 4, 2004 "Status on Mountain View Park Public Process and Recreational Strategic Study", established parameters for a strategic study to determine the extent of Council's long term potential role in accommodating Mountain Biking in the Fromme and Grouse areas including potential GVRD areas on the North Shore,

> And whereas, as part of this decision, it was determined that Council should provide access to such areas on a temporary basis via Mountain View Park,


> And whereas the resulting and actual changes to Mountain View Park, which is a local community park, have severely impacted the environmental integrity of this park and are contrary to the environmental protection parameters outlined in the staff report as well as existing Council policies,

> Therefore be it resolved that the CAO provide a report to Council clarifying and/or explaining such policies on one hand and the actual extensive adverse environmental impact on this community park which appears to be in flagrant violation of any and all District environmental protection guidelines and,

> Further be it resolved that the report contain a reference to what extent these changes to Mountain View Park, including the expenditure of funds in Mountain View Park if any, have predetermined the outcome of the "Recreational Strategic Study" to be presented for Council's consideration in the Fall of 2004.
