 > I want to protest against the Editorial Policy of the North Shore News
 >
 > in it's coverage of the recent Municipal By Election in the District
 > of North Vancouver.
 >
 > While the NEWS clearly has every right to express its own bias through
 > editorial comment, it did not do so. Instead it did so via biased
 > columnists and by means of biased photography.
 >
 > This is not the first time. Some candidates vividly recall when, in
 > the past, including during past elections, the NEWS printed damaging
 > letters from readers about candidates but refused those same
 > candidates any opportunity to respond.
 >
 > This, in my opinion, is totally contrary to the principles of a fair
 > press and fair play.
 >
 > And since we are speaking about NEWS editorials?.....I should like
 > to remind you that the Lynn Valley Library was to contain 15,000
 > square feet of community space. This space however, has been
 > eliminated while the cost for the project has increased from 22
 > Million to \$ 41 million albeit officially only \$ 34 million. This,
 > however, is without the 15.000 square feet of community space which
 > was eliminated. It means in practical terms that the cost of the
 > Library valued at \$14 million will now cost three times as much. And
 > the people who are responsible for this fiasco will at least in part
 > as a result of the editorial bias of the News have even more influence
 > over the affairs of District finances.
