Subject: Abduction Attempt

At approximately 12:10 this afternoon, March 10, the North Vancouver

RCMP responded to a report of what appears to have been an abduction attempt of a 10 year old boy. The incident occurred as the boy was running across the school grounds of Ridgeway Elementary School, located in the 400 block of East 8th Street.

As the child was running across the school grounds, a black or dark skinned male approached the boy and asked him if he "could help him find something in his car". The man grabbed the boy by his wrist and then let go when the child sprinted away from the man's grasp. The victim believes he may have spotted the same male loitering in the area of the school last weekend but was not approached at that time by the suspect.

The suspect is described as follows :  
Black or very dark skinned adult male with a small moustache, wearing blue jeans and a black shirt with no writing on it. The male was also wearing a grey toque and had a puffy grey jacket.

The male was seen leaving the area in a mid-sized blue car with tinted windows and was described as being in rough shape. The car also was driving with a small replacement tire on it.
