Subject: Boil Water Advisory Update


Mayor Harris and Council:

We have now received the results of a sample taken yesterday (Saturday) from the affected area and it is safe. However, we need 3 consecutive days of clean samples with a minimum of 24 hours after each sample is taken for the lab to complete the test, so the projection is that sometime on Tuesday we will be able to lift the advisory.

Between myself and Vancouver Coastal Health we have spoken with CTV, Global and CKNW and have tried to ensure that they are broadcasting the correct information as far as the specific area affected, as it seems that one of the news outlets may have described a more general area that created some confusion. In addition, the GVRD have issued an information release.

I will update you again tomorrow or if there are any new developments.
