Mayor & Council:

On behalf of the Federation of *North Vancouver Community Associations* I would like to thank each of you for attending the April 26th shirtsleeves meeting. FONVCA members felt that the meeting was a very useful forum to informally discuss some pressing issues, and so we look forward to holding future shirtsleeves meetings with you.

Following-up on the meeting, specifically the discussion on funding for improvements to waterfront access, FONVCA unanimously approved the following motion at its May 26th meeting:

"That FONVCA send a letter requesting that unused funds allocated by council for the previous three years, plus the current year, be used to open up the street ends identified at the shirt-sleeves meeting of April 26 2005, using the oldest of the three year funding to avoid loss of these funds."

Referencing the previous years' unused funding in the above motion is extremely important. Ms. Deveaux explained at the shirtsleeves meeting that unused project funds are held for three years, therefore FONVCA suggests that money specifically budgeted three years ago for increased access to the waterfront, should be spent now before being lost for that purpose.
