Hi Jody,

I have just watched the tape of Monday's council meeting on Emergency preparedness and was very surprised by your comments about the NSEMO Community Advisory Panel (CAP). I am the chair of the Seymour Valley Community Association representing approximately 500 homes on both sides of the Seymour River north of the Parkway. Our community association has never received an invitation nor any correspondence regarding this group. Given our community's proximity to Nexen and the Landslide hazards from the Blueridge escarpment we would be very interested in having a representative on this committee.

Have you invited Community Association participation on this committee? A comparable committee is CMAC which is a GVRD sponsored Community Monitoring and Advisory Panel dealing with issues resulting from the GVRD water projects. This panel has representatives from every community association on it and makes a concerted effort to insure that community association send a representative to every meeting. It seems to me that a similar model should be followed in membership on the CAP.
