Your Worship & Members of Council,

Whereas many residents having only carports (and have no wildlife resistant enclosure) are thus unable to safely comply with section 28 of bylaw 7631 (see page 129+ of July 9/2009 Council package) ie.

*"Where garbage is stored outside a building, the solid waste containers(s) for the garbage must be stored in a wildlife resistant enclosure, except during such times that the solid waste container(s) are put out for collection in accordance with this bylaw"*

**I urge council to not adopt this section (28) of the Solid Waste Removal Bylaw.** The storage indoors (eg. disposable diapers), especially during hot weather, would be detrimental to the health and welfare of our residents. I consider the health of our residents to be paramount. Please do not adopt section 28 until such time as a viable alternative (eg. bear-proof containers) are made available.
