The "proposed" redevelopment of Lynn Valley is not in alignment with the Regional Growth Strategy to encourage density along major transit lines.

Developing this area to the extent Bosa and Safeway are proposing is not in keeping with what we Lynn Valleyites hold so dear. The people of Lynn Valley do not want highrises and we do not want thousands more people coming in and out of our community on an already congested road system with inadequate public transportation.
