The trail assessment should be completed by mid Fall. Currently working on a methodology as to how to study the trails on Fromme Mountain.

The Parks Board has put together a stakeholders list which I am on. They should be contacting everyone on that list to hear out their concerns about the state of the trails and the environment on Fromme Mountain.
